

COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST MIFFLIN met in the Municipal Building Council Chambers on Monday, January 7, 2008 at 5:00 p.m. prevailing time for the purpose of reorganizing and swearing in the newly elected Officials of the Borough of West Mifflin.

Mayor Andzelik opened the meeting with a moment of silent prayer followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Andzelik introduced Magistrate Richard Olasz, Jr. who administered the Oath of Office to Council members Joseph Falce, John Munsie and Rhonda Popovich.

Mayor Andzelik called for nominations for President of Council.

Motion by Olasz, seconded by Munsie that Regis Stephenson be nominated for President of Council. Roll Call: Three ayes, four nays (Falce, Jabbour, Popovich, Welsh). **Motion** by Jabbour, seconded by Popovich that William Welsh be nominated for President of Council. Roll Call: Four ayes, three nays (Munsie, Olasz, Stephenson). Motion carried in favor of William Welsh.

William Welsh was declared President of Council for the ensuing term and Mayor Andzelik relinquished the Chair.

Mr. Welsh called for nominations for Vice President of Council.

Motion by Popovich, seconded by Falce that Arlene Jabbour be nominated for Vice President. Roll Call: Four ayes, three nays (Munsie, Olasz, Stephenson). **Motion** by Stephenson, seconded by Munsie that Richard Olasz be nominated for Vice President. Motion carried in favor of Arlene Jabbour.

Arlene Jabbour was declared Vice President of Council.

Motion by Falce, seconded by Popovich to retain Michael Adams of the law firm Adams & Foley, L.L.C. as Borough Solicitor. Roll Call: Four ayes, three nays (Munsie, Olasz, Stephenson). Motion carried.

Motion by Jabbour, seconded by Popovich to retain ATS Chester Engineers as the Borough Engineers. Roll Call: Seven ayes, no nays. Motion carried.

Motion by Olasz, seconded by Stephenson that Melanie Joyce, Manager of the West Mifflin Branch of National City Bank be nominated for Borough Treasurer. Roll Call: Three ayes, four nays (Falce, Jabbour, Popovich, Welsh). **Motion** by Falce, seconded by Jabbour that Howard Bednar be nominated for Borough Treasurer. Roll Call: Four ayes, three nays (Munsie, Olasz, Stephenson). Motion carried in favor of Howard Bednar.

Motion by Olasz, seconded by Stephenson to retain Dodaro, Cambest & Associates as Solicitor for the Planning Commission. Roll Call: Three ayes, four nays (Falce, Jabbour, Popovich, Welsh). **Motion** by Falce, seconded by Jabbour to retain Michael Adams as Solicitor for the Planning Commission. Roll Call: Four ayes, three nays (Munsie, Olasz, Stephenson). Motion carried in favor of Michael Adams.

Motion by Olasz, seconded by Stephenson to retain Dodaro, Cambest & Associates as Solicitor for the Zoning Hearing Board. Roll Call: Three ayes, four nays (Falce, Jabbour, Popovich, Welsh). **Motion** by Falce, seconded by Jabbour to retain Jason Elash as the Solicitor for the Zoning Hearing Board. Roll Call: Four ayes, three nays (Munsie, Olasz, Stephenson). Motion carried in favor of Jason Elash.

Motion by Olasz, seconded by Stephenson to retain Dodaro, Cambest & Associates as Solicitor for the Civil Service Commission. Roll Call: Three ayes, four nays (Falce, Jabbour, Popovich, Welsh). **Motion** by Falce, seconded by Jabbour to retain Jason Elash as Solicitor for the Civil Service Commission. Roll Call: Four ayes, three nays (Munsie, Olasz, Stephenson). Motion carried in favor of Jason Elash.

Motion by Olasz, seconded by Stephenson to nominate Diane Stanesic for the Vacancy Board. Roll Call: Three ayes, four nays (Falce, Jabbour, Popovich, Welsh). **Motion** by Falce, seconded by Popovich to nominate Frank Genes for the Vacancy Board. Roll Call: Four ayes, three nays (Munsie, Olasz, Stephenson). Motion carried in favor of Frank Genes.

Motion by Falce, seconded by Popovich to appoint National City Bank and Pennsylvania Local Government Investment Trust as the depositories for Borough funds. Roll Call: Seven ayes, no nays. Motion carried.

Motion by Falce, seconded by Popovich to appoint the Daily News and the Valley Mirror as the official Borough newspapers. Roll Call: Seven ayes, no nays. Motion carried.

Motion by Falce, seconded by Jabbour to retain all non-union full-time and part-time paid personnel of the Borough. Roll Call: Seven ayes, no nays. Motion carried.
